As we prepare for spring cleaning and yard clean-up, please remember that grass goes to a pile on the left before you drive through the gate at the yard waste area. Everything is a little easier to get to now. Burnable items are still ONLY limited to yard debris, trees or shrubs; no manufactured lumber is allowed. Please clear vegetation on corner intersections for safer view of traffic and kids walking to school. Also for safety and response time, please dial 911 to report fires. Do not call city hall to report emergencies.

The Town has begun a new sidewalk project on 2nd Street and Main Avenue. During some of this time, traffic will need to be rerouted. New sidewalks and drainage issues will be addressed. We hope to solve problems, not cause any traffic issues. It should all be completed before Farm Fest.


