Season Greetings to all! I want everyone to know that the LaCrosse Library is open Monday from 2-6pm and Thursdays from 10am-2pm. The LaCrosse Library has FREE at home COVID test kits. Simple pick up your kit at the library, register your kit online, collect a sample in your own home and ship. Come in and get yours today. Great to have on hand.

Do you have left over or expired medications? Never flush it or throw it in the trash. Come to the library and get a FREE kit. The kit provides a prepaid envelope where you can mail your unused pills to the proper disposal company at no cost to you. I also have free sharps containers and inhalator disposal kits. This is all free of charge. For young kids we have weekly Storytime Bags to go. Each week we have different subject matter to choose from. Inside each bag is work sheets, books, a craft and a candy treat. Come check out our selection.

The library is still not able to have in person programs and do to this rule I will not be able to have the ornament making while you visit with Santa on Saturday December 4th.
