MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR:

This year will be a busy time for Main Street as we are finishing up the construction part of our Transportation Improvement Board Grant. In April, we will be working on repairing the drainage issue in front of the café and bank. We will be crack sealing Main Street from the RV park to A Street in May. Chip sealing will continue in late June and July. Striping will be done in August.

Due to our governor's proclamation, all council meetings are being held the 2nd Thursday of the month via Zoom. If you would like to join a council meeting, please call 509-549-3330 or email Angela lacrosse@pionnet.com the day before each meeting to get a link.

At the end of last year, council decided to terminate the code enforcement position. Council decided the mayor and council would like to handle the issues in town. Remember dog licenses are required for all dogs in the town limits and are due by the March 31st. Also cats are required to have a lifetime cat license.

Spring will be here soon and grass and weeds will grow quickly. LaCrosse Ordinance 340 states: All weeds, grass or other uncultivated vegetation shall be cut and disposed of at least once each month during the months of April through September, and in no event shall any such weeds, grass or vegetation be allowed to exceed twelve inches in height. Let's keep our town looking nice and be good neighbors.

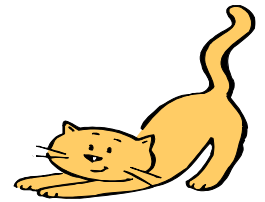
