Right now it looks like spring, but I don't think we are through with winter yet! Continue to keep sidewalks clear and parking open for Don and Tony to plow streets.

Our TIB grant sidewalk project for 2nd Street, from Main Street to Crystal, has been combined with a new grant, the TIB Main Street sidewalk project. The Main Street sidewalk will go from about town hall down towards the park. These projects are planned to be constructed in 2024.

There has been some interest in trapping some of the feral cats roaming town. The town will loan the city traps to those interested for a \$25 deposit. When the trap is returned in good condition, the \$25 deposit will be returned. The deposit will only be kept by the town if there is damage to the trap. We are all eager to see the cat situation improve.

Due to some increase in criminal activity around town and throughout the area I will be contacting the Whitman County Sheriff's Department to see about increased patrols. Watching for improper activity is always helpful. Call the Sheriff if something looks suspicious!
