MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR

Weather is changing slowly at least it isn't still snowing! Please take the opportunity to mow and do yard maintenance when you get the chance. The clear view ordinance and others will be enforced by our new code enforcement officer Ed Casey. We welcome his knowledge and help with our town's issues. Many thanks to Ed in advance.

The city dump will be closing June 12th as it is already full and we haven't been able to burn due to our extremely wet winter and spring. Our town ordinance states: No yardwaste burning between May 1st to September 30th. So, be prepared for the closing.

We are finishing up the Wastewater Improvement Project. The grant/loan funds allowed the town to put in new generators and upgrade electrical at the sewer lift stations. A new pressure line was installed from lift station to lagoon. The lagoon was graded and locating equipment was purchased. It also allowed us to purchase a new pickup with a crane attachment to service the lift station pumps. The last pickup the town purchased was back in 1993.

We are looking into getting a grant to replace our water storage. An above ground tank would provide greater water pressure to properties. Everything is just being investigated at this point.

Enjoy the clean-up weather in between the rains!

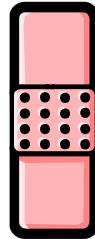

at the end of the parade on June 24th

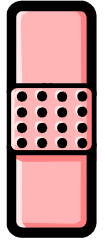
