

May 12, 2016

The minutes of a regular meeting of the Town Council, of the Town of LaCrosse held May 12, 2016. Mayor Camp called the meeting to order at the Town Hall at 7:00 pm. C Cauley, C Downing, and C Mackleit were present. Also present Don Keeney, Tony Lofink and 11 members of the community.

The minutes of a regular meeting of April were read. A motion was made to accept minutes by C Cauley and seconded by C Downing. Motion passed.

The Treasurer's report was distributed to council. C Cauley moved to accept. Motion seconded by C Mackleit. Motion passed.

UNDER PUBLIC CONCERNS: None

SHERIFF'S REPORT: None

UNDER OLD BUSINESS: Jim Nelson addressed council on returning his sheep for the next 30 days. Jim asked for the two complaints to be read. Jim had nine neighbors give statements to the council that they had no issue of an odor or otherwise of the sheep being in Jim's fenced yard. A letter from Wendy Fleming was also given to council stating she had no odor or noise issues and would like to support his business in town. Jim also gave council a letter with research information for council to consider adopting a "temporary grazing permit". No motion was made to reverse the 30 day on and 30 off and 30 day on again to Jim and the sheep.

The council would like the mayor to talk to Darin Barry and request a copy of the statement from his engineer on the condition of the remaining walls.

The town had the preconstruction meeting with DW Excavating and TD&H Engineering today. We anticipate the project to begin June 1st and to finish in 50 working days.

C Cauley questioned getting the kiosk up in the mini park and crack sealing the streets this summer. Don stated the mural painter had equipment in the way and he will to crack seal around the sewer improvement project.

Pegram was paid their retainage. C Cauley made a motion to accept the Water Improvement Project as complete. Seconded by C Mackleit. Motion passed.

UNDER NEW BUSINESS: The receipt register and the adjusted past due utility report were reviewed by council.

Five Construction Companies were called to give an estimate on repairing the shop roof from the Whitman Co Small Works Roster. Don had only received one phone call back with questions.

No objections were given to have the LaCrosse Market receive a liquor license under a new name.

Kathleen Parker addressed council on cleaning up an area by the yard waste dump. The ground between Star and Hill at the end of 1st street was questioned if that still belongs to the city.

Don Keeney explained to council he had ordered an air compressor and it had not arrived and would like to cancel that order and order a new one through a different company. Council had no objections.

A motion to approve the bills for April 9345-9371 for claims in the amount of \$61,143.17 and Payroll in the amount of \$9,838.21 and EFT in the amount of \$2,215.17 was made by C Cauley and seconded by C Downing. Motion passed.

C Cauley moved to adjourn the meeting. C Downing seconded. Meeting adjourned at 8:00pm.
